

## Living Expenses

NorQuest is located at the heart of downtown Edmonton. Here is a rough guide to living expenses in Edmonton.

### Single Student:

Expenses	Monthly	8 months	12 months
Accommodations*	\$800 - \$1,300	\$6,400 - \$10,400	\$9,600 - \$15,600
Food	\$350	\$2,800	\$4,200
Clothing	\$200	\$1,600	\$2,400
Phone	\$80	\$640	\$960
Miscellaneous	\$100	\$800	\$1,200
<b>Total</b>	\$1,600 - \$2,100	\$12,200 - \$16,200	\$18,300 - \$24,300

\*Some accommodations will only include water and heat in the rent. Other utilities, such as electricity and internet are separate expenses.

\*\*Public transport pass (ARC card), and health and dental insurance is already part of the school fees and therefore are not included in the table above.

Note: All fees are in Canadian dollars. The above information is only an estimate of the living expenses for a single student. All fees are determined by students' lifestyles.

### Students with Family:

Number of Persons	Minimum Living Expenses
Single student	Tuition plus \$18,000 for a 12-month period (or \$1,500 per month)
+ One family member	\$5,000 for a 12-month period (or \$333 per month)
+ Each additional family member	\$3,000 for a 12-month period per dependent child of any age (or \$255 per month)
