Types of transit in Edmonton:

- Buses
- Edmonton Light Rail Transit (LRT)

How to find where the bus/train is going

- The buses run in two directions; the front and the side of the bus will tell you where it is going.
- Bus stop signs will tell you which bus stops in that location and what the final destination will be.
- The train has two lines that run in opposite directions: Capital and Metro.

Paying for the transit

Any of the following could be used to pay:

- **Arc Card** -you can get it from SANQC, but it is not available for students in non-credit programs. For questions about the Arc card, contact: students.association@norquest.ca
- **Cash Fare of \$3.50** -ticket valid for 90 minutes
- **Single use ticket** -could be purchased from [ETS Online Store](#) or a retail store like shoppers
- **Monthly Bus Pass**-could be purchased from [ETS Online Store](#) or a retail store like shoppers
