



## How to set up utilities

The first thing that you are required to do when you move into a rented apartment is to set up the utilities like electricity (if it is not included in your rent) and internet.

## **Electricity**

To set up the electricity supply, <u>build your energy plan</u> and get started.

## Internet

Most apartments may have discounted rates with different internet providers, so make sure to check It with the apartment renting company.

**Note:** Make sure you are receiving monthly charges for all utilities you are responsible for. If you are not getting bills, contact your retailer as soon as possible. Even if you do not receive your bill, you are still responsible for any late payment penalties.
