Health Career Programs

PRACTICAL NURSE DIPLOMA

Join the largest Practical Nurse Diploma program in Canada! This program prepares you to become a professional practical nurse who can give high-quality care to clients. Almost 100 percent of our PN graduates pass the national examination on their first try and become licensed practical nurses. *Take up to three years to complete the program. Part-time evening classes are held weekly, plus some weekends. Distance learning is either group- or self-paced. Cost per course: Beginning at \$270**

HEALTH CARE AIDE (HCA) CERTIFICATE

With a 99 percent employment rate, graduates of NorQuest's Health Care Aide program are in high demand! You will gain the essential knowledge and skills required to work in acute care, continuing-care centres and home-care agencies. This program meets the Continuing Care Standards education requirements. *Part-time evening classes begin in fall or spring and are held twice weekly, plus some Saturdays. The practicum is completed on a part-time basis over a 7-week period. Distance learning classes begin in fall or winter and are group-paced. Complete the program in 24 to 31 weeks. Program cost: \$1,936**

PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSISTANT DIPLOMA PROGRAM

This program prepares you to work under the direction of physical therapists, helping clients with injuries or physically debilitating conditions. THERAPEUTIC RECREATION CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA PROGRAMS

Our Therapeutic Recreation program is all about wellness through leisure! You will learn how to prepare and deliver recreation and leisure activities such as crafts, community outings and music therapy sessions for clients who have physical, mental or social limitations. Graduates with a certificate may work as an assistant under the direction of a recreation therapist, while those with a diploma are able to work more independently. *Completion of the certificate program is a prerequisite for the diploma program. Take up to 18 months to complete each program by distance learning. Cost per course: Beginning at \$306**

Upgrade your skills or explore areas of interest. Our continuing education programs and courses are varied and designed to meet your needs. *Study options include weekend or evening workshops, self-study and distance learning.*

ESSENTIAL LEADERSHIP SKILLS FOR HEALTH-CARE PROFESSIONALS

This program offers team leaders and supervisors the skills they need to make the most of their number one resource—their people! Develop your interpersonal skills. OFFICE PROFESSIONAL

Prepare for a career as an office professional in today's modern, multifaceted office environment. Office Professional graduates are in high demand as Alberta's economy continues to flourish. Core courses teach keyboarding skills as well as how to use computer software programs such as MS Word, Excel, Access and Outlook. In addition, learn about office procedures, business writing and professional relations. Specialize in one of three streams in Semester 2.

Become qualified in your trade or technical field while earning a certificate that leads to employment. NorQuest's Pre-Apprenticeship and Industry Training can help you develop marketable employment skills and prepare you to enter an industry or service career with confidence. *Study at our Edmonton Downtown Campus.*

APPRENTICESHIP PREP

This program is designed to prepare you for entry into one of 50 designated trades. Instruction in math, science, computers and practical trades skills will prepare you to write the Apprenticeship Entrance Exam. Upgrade your educational foundation with Alberta Education credit courses, or equivalency courses that are accepted for entry into Alberta universities and colleges. Courses are available at the pre-high school and high school levels. *Customize your learning program to your specific needs.*

ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM

Open the door to a successful future. Become a better reader and improve your literacy skills with other adult learners. This unique program will help you achieve the essential skills you need for upgrading and employment in reading, writing, communicating, math and computers. *There are six levels of ALP. Course placement will be based on a detailed assessment. Fall and winter start dates. Cost per course: \$482**

PREP FOR HIGH SCHOOL COURSES

Improve your reading, writing and math skills at the pre-high school level. One-on-one instruction combined with self-study allows you to progress at your own pace. *Monthly start dates available; 15 to 18 weeks. Cost per course: \$321**

» **Basic Math:** Choose from four different math courses. Focus on addition, subtraction, algebra, polynomials, measurement and geometry, or study whole numbers and general math skills including fractions, decimals, ratios and proportions.

GED PREP

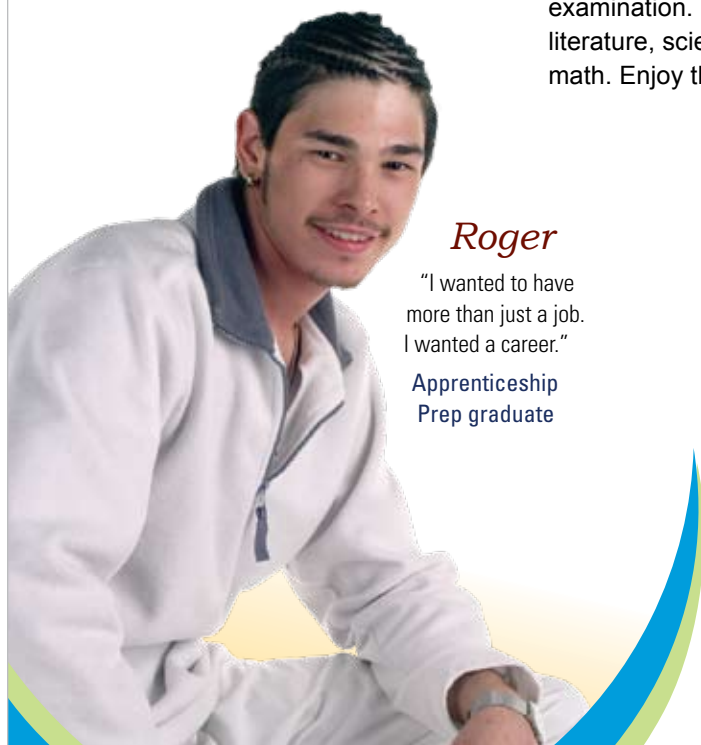

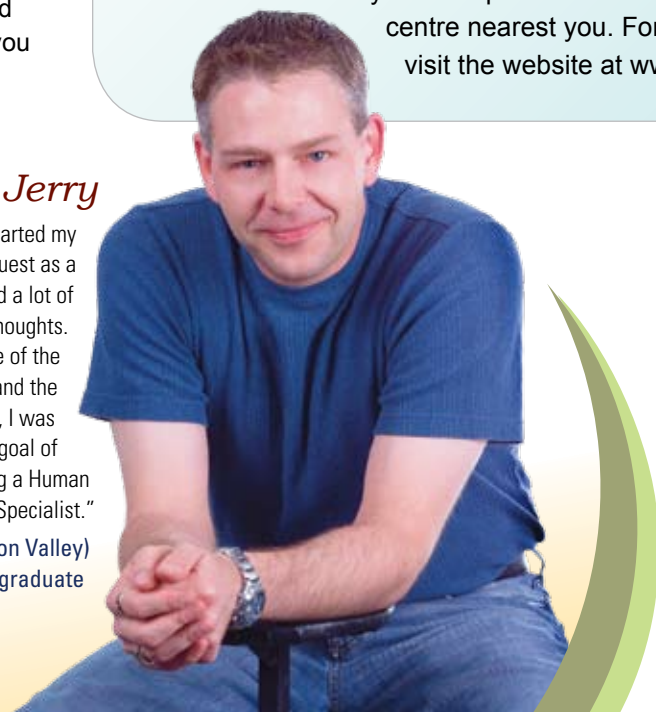

Language Training Programs

Learn English or improve your English language skills with Edmonton's largest English as a Second Language (ESL) provider. NorQuest's wide range of language training programs gives you the English skills you need to succeed in the workplace and in post-secondary education. *Classes are held at the Edmonton Downtown Campus.*

ESL INTENSIVE, DAYTIME COURSES

Do you need a part-time program in English as a second language to succeed in your academic, professional or personal goals? The ESL Intensive program can help. Learn to communicate with confidence in a variety of situations. Improve your pronunciation and expand your vocabulary. Practise in a language lab to improve your speaking and listening skills. *Reading and writing courses are held in the mornings; listening and speaking courses are held in the afternoons. Multiple*

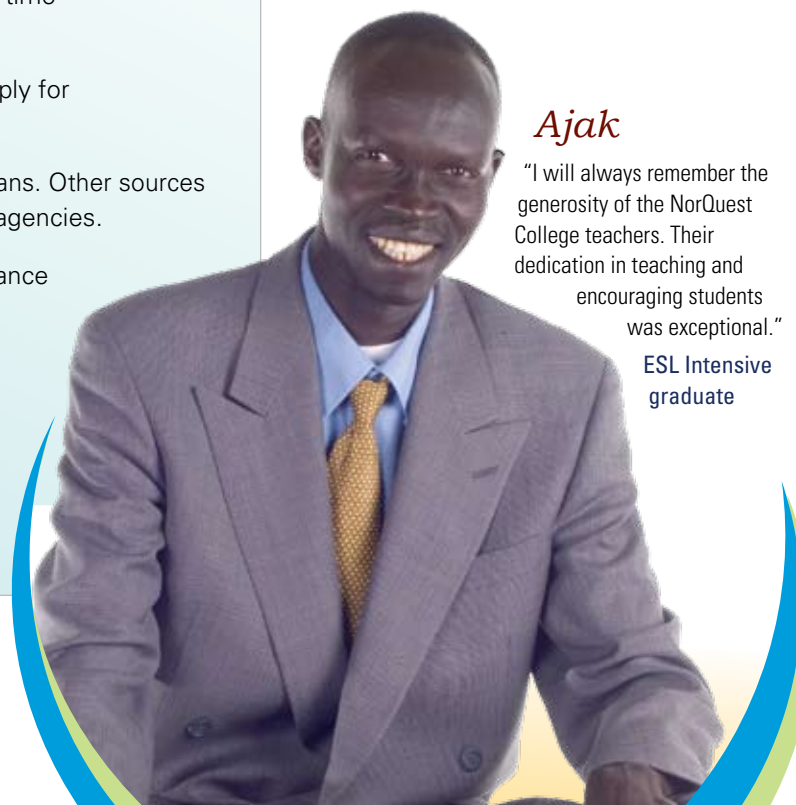
Canada/Alberta Student Loans: Full-time and part-time post-secondary students may apply for Canada/Alberta Student Loans. Applications are available at NorQuest College.

Customized Training for Companies

WORKPLACE COMMUNICATION TRAINING

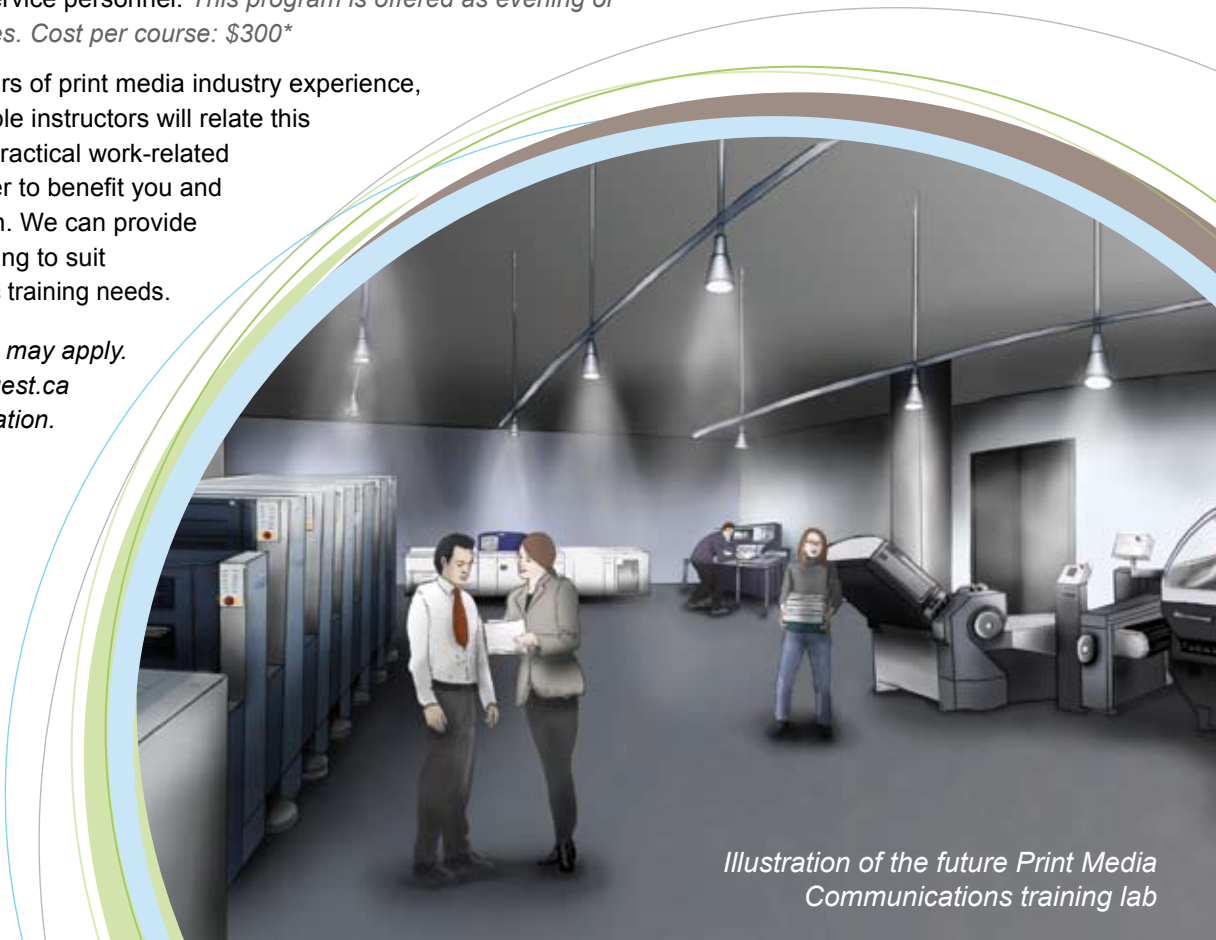


Illustration of the future Print Media Communications training lab

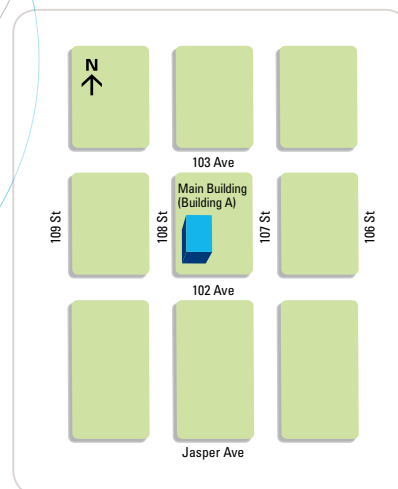
