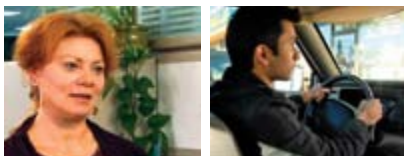
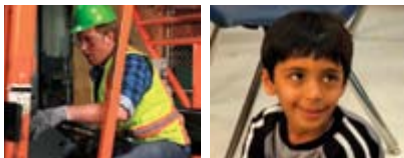

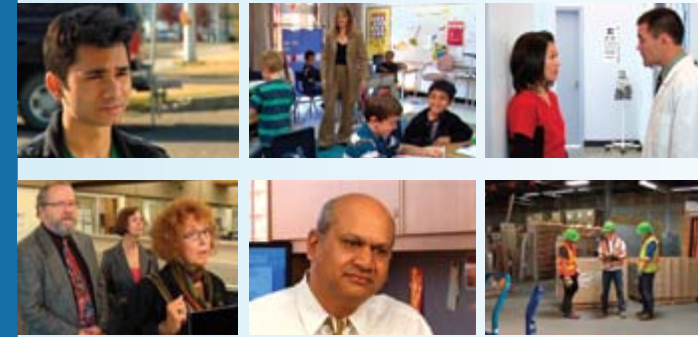


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Interactive English 2 is a collection of six stories about the Tremblay family, three generations who get together to celebrate important days in Canadian family life. They share stories about events in their lives, such as dealing with a car accident or sorting out a misunderstanding in the workplace.

The stories are designed to develop reading, listening, vocabulary, and cultural literacy skills for ESL and literacy students from diverse cultural backgrounds. This skill development is supported by interactive texts and activities.



Watch the Video

View a video about a problem that one family member encountered. Each video is 5 to 8 minutes in length.



Practise and Review: Listening

Listen and read as four former ESL learners respond to each problem-solving story. These short vignettes portray language learners' feelings about intercultural issues.



Listen and Read

Next, read and hear the story with embedded definitions for selected vocabulary, and interactive activities that check comprehension.



Practise and Review: Writing

Record and express ideas in CLB-based tasks such as list making; creating a simple form; and writing an invitation, social note, or personal memory.



Practise and Review: Vocabulary

See new, topical words in context. Explore plain language definitions. Answer questions using these words.



Teacher Resource

Choose from supplementary post-reading activities that apply the vocabulary and problem-solving skills to other situations, including the learners' own lives. Find additional ideas for use in classroom or tutorial settings.

Interactive English 2 supports development of reading and listening skills from levels 2 to 4 of the Canadian Language Benchmarks by embedding language instruction in real-life scenarios.

It supports the development of functional literacy skills in a Canadian cultural context. This resource is designed for ESL and literacy learners with varying levels of computer and language skills.
