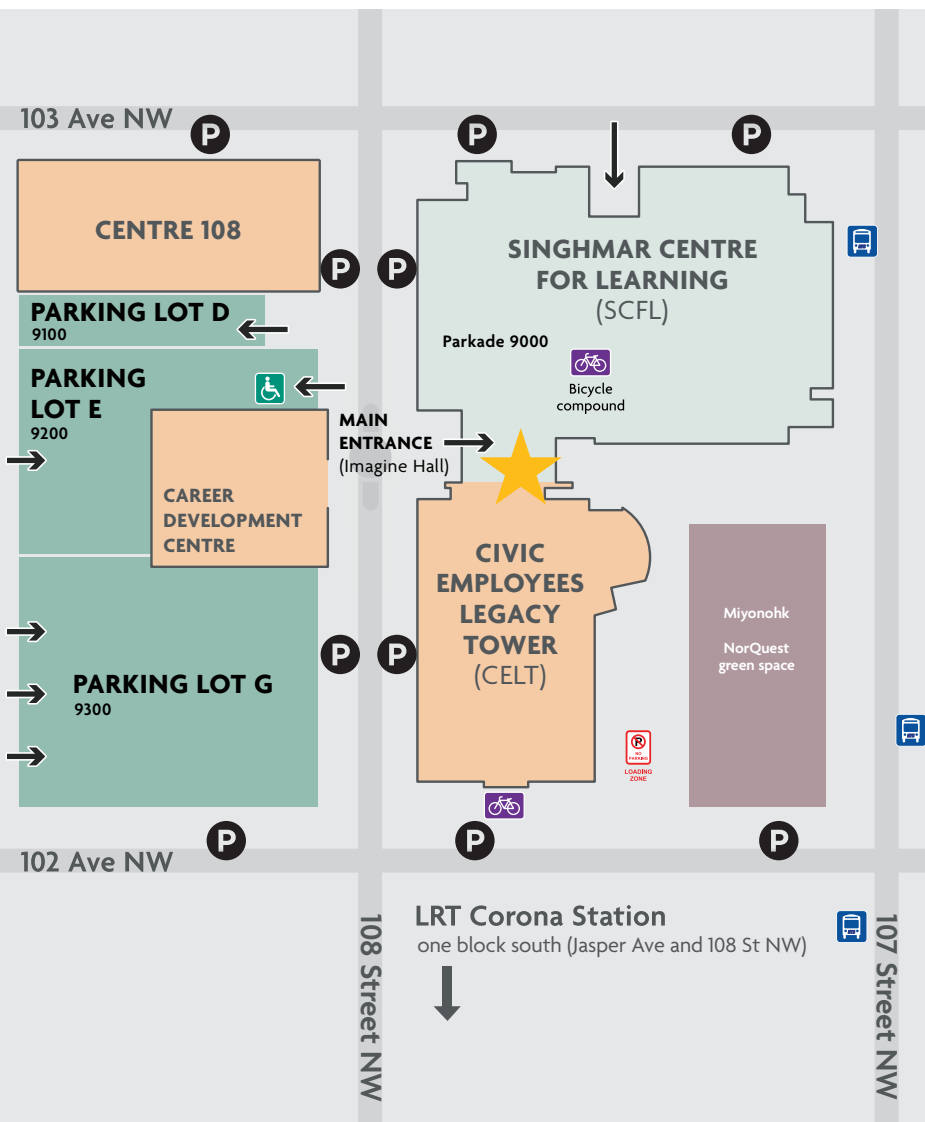

Career Mythbusters: Debunking Job Search Misconceptions

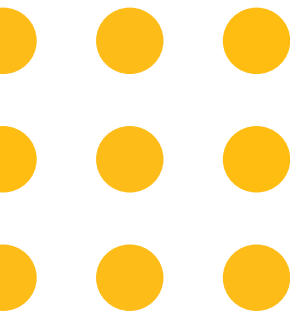
