

Applying for an Alberta ID

If you are an Alberta resident/student who can legally live in Canada and do not have a valid driver's license, you can apply for an ID card to use as photo identification. You can apply for your ID card by visiting a [registry agent](#) close to you.

The minimum age to hold an ID card is 12 years old. Applicants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to provide consent. The registry agent will provide you with a 30-day ID card receipt to use until your new ID card arrives in the mail (up to 21 days).

Requirements to apply for an Alberta ID

- Study Permit
- Passport
- Proof of residence - **one** of the following:
 - Residential lease agreement
 - Utility bills
 - Bank or credit card statement
 - Written confirmation of Alberta's employment (must be signed and dated)

Additional supporting documents may be requested to confirm AHCIP eligibility.

Price

- The price for an Alberta ID for 1 year is \$14 plus GST
- The price for an Alberta ID for 2 years is \$23 plus GST
