Addictions Recovery Practitioner

Program Overview

The Addictions Recovery Practitioner post-diploma certificate program provides health and human services professionals with the knowledge and skills to work with clients experiencing substance use and concurrent disorders. The program is offered in a flexible combination of online courses and live classroom instruction on evenings and weekends.

The program emphasizes acquisition of applied skills and best practices in direct client care, advocacy, ethics, and work with families and communities. The program builds upon students' previous training and experience, and graduates are equipped to meet client and employer needs in a range of relevant settings.

Career Potential

The Addictions Recovery Practitioner program will provide a viable career pathway for those entering the field of addictions. Graduates may pursue further education at the bachelor's and master's level, in areas such as social work, addictions, mental health, program administration, management, and research.

Admission Requirements

- diploma or degree in health, human services, or social sciences from a college or university in Canada or abroad

ELP Requirements

If English is your second language, you must provide proof of English language proficiency (ELP) prior to admission. ELP test results must have been obtained within two years of the start date of your program.

Acceptable evidence of ELP may be one of the following test scores:

- CLBA: no section score below 8
- IELTS Academic: 6.5; no section score below 6
- TOEFL iBT: 84; no section score below 21
- CELPIP General: 8; no section score below 7
- CAEL: 60; no section score below 60
- minimum of 80% in [Listening/Speaking 8000 \(ESLS8000\)](#) or [Listening/Speaking 8100 \(ESLS8100\)](#), and 80% in [Reading/Writing 8000 \(ESLW8000\)](#) or [Reading/Writing 8100 \(ESLW8100\)](#); or minimum of 50% in [English for Academic Purposes - Reading and Writing \(ESLG1860\)](#) and [English for Academic Purposes - Listening and Speaking \(ESLG1861\)](#)

Note: ELP is a separate requirement from the English academic admission requirement.
