You must provide proof of ELP prior to admission. ELP test results must have been obtained within two years of the start date of your program.

Acceptable evidence of ELP may be one of the following test scores:

- CLBPT or CLBA: no section score below 4
- IELTS Academic: 4
- TOEFL iBT: 32
- CELPIP General: 4
- Duolingo: 75
- minimum of 80% in [ESLS 4000](#) or [ESLS 4100](#), and 80% in [ESLW 4000](#) or [ESLW 4100](#)
