NorQuest Bridging to Post-Secondary

Program Overview

NorQuest Bridging to Post-Secondary provides an opportunity to students who need additional English language or academic upgrading courses to fully meet admission requirements for a post-secondary program.

ELP Requirements

Each NorQuest Bridging applicant must provide proof of English language proficiency (ELP) prior to admission. ELP test results must have been obtained within two years of the start date of the NorQuest Bridging program.

The following minimum ELP scores are for students who do not require any Academic Upgrading coursework during their Bridging program. Applicants who also require Academic Upgrading need higher ELP scores.

Acceptable evidence of ELP for students seeking admission to **Band E programs** may be one of the following:

- IELTS Academic: 4.5; no section score below 4.0
- TOEFL iBT: 34
- Duolingo: 75
- minimum of 80% in **ESLS 4000** or **ESLS 4100**, and 80% in **ESLW 4000** or **ESLW 4100**

Acceptable evidence of ELP for students seeking admission to **Band F programs** may be one of the following:

- IELTS Academic: 5.0; no section score below 4.5
- TOEFL iBT: 40
- Duolingo: 85
- minimum of 80% in **ESLS 5000** or **ESLS 5100**, and 80% in **ESLW 5000** or **ESLW 5100**

Acceptable evidence of ELP for students seeking admission to **Band H programs** may be one of the following:

- IELTS Academic: 5.5; no section score below 5.0, and the Listening score must be at least 5.5
- TOEFL iBT: 52
- Duolingo: 95
- minimum of 80% in **ESLS 6000** or **ESLS 6100**, and 80% in **ESLW 6000** or **ESLW 6100**
