

Objective

This policy identifies the principles used by NorQuest College (college) to establish or revise tuition and related fees.

Authority to establish this policy is derived from the <u>NorQuest College Board of Governor's Policy No.5</u>, which delegates authority to the President and CEO to establish policies and procedures for the college's management and operation.

Policy

NorQuest College develops or revises tuition and related fees in an open and transparent manner that considers the following:

- Meets all requirements and guidelines of Advanced Education,
- Assures compliance with the *Alberta Post-Secondary Learning Act* and Tuition and Fees Regulation,
- Ensures appropriate consultation and discussion with students.

All tuition fees are subject to approval of the NorQuest College Board of Governors as required under Section 61 of the *Alberta Post-Secondary Learning Act*.
